It is therefore necessary for students to learn how to critically analyze several significant regulations in regard with cyber activities, in order to evaluate the compatibility and comprehensive cyber regulation. In addition, students are able to discern the complexity of cyber regulation to resolve dispute concerning cyber activities.</p>
